

How to play memePoint

1. Gather 3–8 players and sit around a table.
2. Shuffle the caption cards and deal 7 cards to each player. Place the remaining caption cards in a draw pile in the center. Players may look at their own cards only.
3. Choose a judge for the first round. The judge does not play a caption card, but selects the winning meme.
4. The judge selects a photo card and places it face up for everyone to see. All other players choose the caption card they feel best pairs with the photo and submit it face down to the judge.
5. The judge shuffles the caption cards and reads them aloud.
6. The judge selects their favorite caption. The winning player keeps the photo card (1 photo card = 1 point).
7. All players draw back up to 7 caption cards. The judge role passes to the player on the left and a new round begins.
8. The player with the most photo cards at the end of the game wins.

TIP: If a blank card is played, all players create their own caption instead (spoken aloud or written down).
